- Writing fronted adverbial phrases (After that, Just then,)
- Punctuating speech correctly

Numeracy

Place Value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division

- Count in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 100
- Find 1000 more or less than a given number and recognise the value of each digit in a 4 digit number
- Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000
- Add and subtract numbers with up to four digits, using formal written methods of column addition and subtraction
- Recall multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12
- Count up and down in hundredths

Science

Animals, including Humans

- Describe basic functions of the digestive system- labelling the digestive system explaining what each function does as part of the digestion process
- Identify different types of teeth- label human and animal teeth identify similarities and differences
- Construct and interpret variety of food chains, identifying predators and prey

PSHE

Getting On and Falling Out

- To describe the different ways conflict makes us feel and behave
- To identify positive ways of resolving conflict
- To demonstrate conflict resolution skills such as negotiating, compromising and turn taking

MFL

We will learn animal names in Spanish and use adjectives to describe them.

Using Audacity, we will learn how to layer sounds to create a soundscape.

PE

- To perform Roman inspired dances using a range of movement patterns
- Tennis- throwing, catching and hitting skills change the length pace and directions of their throws

Forest Schools

We will explore autumn, participating in activities such as scavenger hunts, species identification and autumnal artwork.
