

Literacy

Year three will be learning all about Greek myths this term. We will be learning Theseus and the Minotaur and then writing our own quest based myth set in Ancient Greece.

Later in the term, we'll also study Aesop's fables and write our own moral tale in the style of Aesop's.

We will also study information texts. We will look at the features and language used and apply this when writing our own information text.

Numeracy

In the summer term, year three will be learning about adding and subtracting fractions, calculating fractions in problems and applying fractions in real life situations.

Later in the term, we will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes, area and perimeter and reviewing our learning on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Science

In science, year three will learn about plants.

We'll be identifying the different parts and functions of flowering plants, we'll learn what plants require to keep them healthy and will explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of plants.

We will investigate how different plants reproduce and how plants take in water.

PSHE Relationships

In PSHE, we'll be learning about relationships; what a good relationship is and how to maintain good relationships with other people.

Ancient Greece

Summer Term

MFL

We will learn to say names of fruits, say if we like/dislike them, learn the names of the days of the week/months of the year and consolidate other topics from over the year.

Art / D&T

This term our focus will be on paint. The children will use a variety of different size brushes, pallet knives and toothbrushes to produce artwork. They will have the opportunity to explore different paints; water colour, acrylic and poster. We will be studying the art of Monet, Van Gogh and Peter Lanyon.

In D&T the children will be designing, making and evaluating a puppet to perform a play. During this project they will explore and evaluate different techniques to join fabric and ways of using templates and simple pattern pieces.

PE

This term we'll be learning to play the game of rounders and tennis and will be developing our throwing, catching and batting skills. Later in the term, we'll be working on our athletics skills.

Music

We will have whole class ensemble lessons on the ukulele and perform to other classes and to parents in a concert.

RE

In RE, year three will learning about important historical leaders from both the Christian and Hindu traditions.

Computing

This term the children will create their own database. They will use it to generate bar charts, to sort and search the records in order to answer questions, e.g. How many children have blonde hair? We will learn how to independently use still and video cameras, download and edit files in order to create a presentation.

Humanities

This term, our topic is the Ancient Greeks. We'll be learning about the history of Greece, the way that the Ancient Greeks lived and their contribution to our modern way of life.

Forest Schools & Gardening

We will be exploring colour in nature- focussing on different shades of the same colour and relating back to the children's work in art. Children will create pieces of 'land art' using natural resources of their choice. Children will have the opportunity to create dream catchers or looms using willow, wool, weaving and natural resources. In the garden, children will be able plant seeds and harvest and sample produce as they become available.
